WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

A Career in TV? Television Studio Operations with Mr. Minkle **Cost \$80 (Grades 5&6) Sessions II & V**
Have you ever wondered how to operate a television studio. Now is the time to learn the inner workings. Mr. Minkle, who runs Channel 6, Derry Educational Television, will teach this class. You will learn studio operations. How do you operate the studio equipment: the video switcher, the audio mixer, cameras, graphics. You may do a newscast or a talk show once you learn the basics on the equipment. You may spend some time outside the studio taping footage to add to the in-studio show. There will be something new every day.

All Sports with Coaches Bruns and Burke **Cost \$55 Sessions II & IV (1-6)**
This session gives boys and girls the opportunity to participate in a variety of team sports and large group games, such as Popcorn, Monarchy, Freedom Ball and many more! It is geared to teach skills while experiencing fun games in a fast-paced environment that will keep the participant moving.

Ancient Crafts with Ms. Landers **Cost \$80 Session II (4-8)**
Working with your hands can be fun. Discovering how ancient people lived can be eye opening. Putting yourself in the place of the Ancient Greeks, Romans or Chinese can be awesome. When you join the Ancient Crafts class you can see how these people lived their daily lives. You will create replicas of objects they used everyday. Come with a sense of curiosity and be ready to get messy and have fun.

Archery with Mr. White from Art of Archery **Cost \$105 Session I (2-5), Session II (5-9), Session III (6-12)**
Fun, excitement and focus are available in this very cool individualized sport. (*Note grade limits.)

Band with Mr. Christen **Cost \$85**
The summer band flyer is online at sau10.org or get one from your school band teacher. This is a two week program with an 8:00-10:00 session for incoming 6th grade students and a 10:15-12:15 session for those who have completed 6th, 7th, or 8th grade. There will be a concert on the last day of the camp, July 24th.

Be A Computer Picasso with Picasa with Mrs. Hoffman **Cost \$80 Session I (6-8) Session II (4-5)**
Learn simple photo editing, make photo collages, burn photo CD's and more with Picasa software. Bring in photos to use or take photos during class. Cameras are provided.

Birds, Bees and Butterflies with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$80 Session V (Grades 2-4)**
Students will focus on creating insects through clay, paper machie' and drawing. We will read stories about insects and birds before we create.

Bubble -ology **Cost \$80** Ms. Ogden **Session I (K-3)** Ms. Ramsey **Session V (K-3)**
The world of bubbles...What do we know? What can we imagine? What do they do? And what can you do with them? Is it science? Is it literature? Is it math? Is it art? Or is it just fun? Have you ever stood inside a bubble?

Bubble-ology Two with Ms. Ramsey **Cost \$80 Session IV (3-5)**
Some cool things that bring bubbles, the art of, the science of, the fun of, to another level.

Cupcake Carnival with Ms. Ogden **Cost \$90 Session IV (1-3)**
Experimenting with cupcakes for the younger set. What sorts of cupcake experiments and creatures can you imagine? A full carnival of cupcake ideas! What will you make each day to take home?

Chess, CHEEZ-ITZ & Checkers with Mr. Sargent **Cost \$70 Sessions II & VI (4-12)**
Beat the summer heat, and practice your gaming skills! Compete against your fellow classmates in a game of strategy with Chess, checkers, and other board games.....OHHH, and then there's CHEEZ-ITZ, of course. Different flavors each day! Mr. Sargent is a retired chess champ!

Cribbage Tutorial for Beginners and Pros with Mr. Sargent **Cost \$75 Sessions III & V (5-12)**
Join a tutorial of this game of cards and peg scoreboard. Whether you are a beginner and just learning the game or you are a pro seeking competition this workshop will challenge you where you are. You will take home your own cribbage board.

Creative Writing with Ms. O'Neil **Cost \$75 Sessions IV & V (5-9)**

In this writing workshop atmosphere young authors will learn the tricks of the writing trade that will turn their good ideas into great stories.

Enchanted Engineering with Ms. Ogden **Cost \$80 Sessions II & VI (1-3)**

Your favorite fairy tale characters need your help! Come build a sturdy house for the three little pigs to keep the Big Bad Wolf out, make a zip-line escape route for Little Red, design a parachute for Jack as a quick get-away from the giant, and more hands on science and engineering activities.

Fun with Art History with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$80 Session IV (Grades 3-5)**

We will draw whimsical cats with chalk pastels as we learn about the artist Laurel Burch. Create fun images of Pop Art as we learn about Andy Warhol. Paint fun desserts inspired by Wayne Thiebaud. This class will explore some famous artists and their unique styles.

Gardens, Flowers and Fruit with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$80 Session 1 (Grades 3-5)**

We will look at artwork by Monet, O'Keeffe and Cezanne'. This drawing class will include chalk pastels, pen&ink and colored pencils. Have fun drawing beautiful gardens, flowers and summer fruit.

Guitar for Beginners with Jay Latulippe from Let's Play Music **Cost \$80 Session I (4-8)**

Have you ever imagined joining or even starting your own band? Or have you ever imagined being able to sit alone and create your own music? Either way, the guitar may be the place to begin! Join us for introductory classes with this terrific instrument. Let us know if you will not be bringing your own guitar - we can provide one for the class.

Lego Mindstorm Robotics with Ms. Strike **Cost \$80 Session IV (5-8)**

This program is the Lego Mindstorm Robotics design course. Students will learn to design, build and program Lego Mindstorm robots. No previous experience is necessary, just a desire to try new things. (*This is a great training program for the Lego Robotics Teams found at both Middle Schools.)

Olaf's FROZEN Adventure!!!! with Ms. Sargent **Cost \$80 Sessions I & V (K-2)**

Sick of the Summer heat?? Well, LET IT GO.....and enter a FROZEN world of FUN with daily songs, stories, crafts, snacks, and games from your favorite movie FROZEN!!!!

Outdoor Group Sporting Activities with Coaches Bruns and Burke. **Cost \$55 Sessions I & V (1-6)**

This will be based on outdoor team activities such as ultimate Frisbee, flag football, kickball, soccer, and capture the flag. Some emphasis will be on learning to be a team player while enjoying the fun of participating in a sport.

Shipwrecked! With Ms. Ogden **Cost \$80 Sessions III & V (3-6)**

You and your crew have been stranded on an deserted island after a storm. How can you survive? Join us for a week of hands on survival science and engineering activities. Learn to make a compass, build a floating raft out of recycled materials, and much more.

Sidewalks, Stories & Snacks with Ms. Sargent **Cost \$85 Sessions II & VI (K-2)**

Learn to cook cool snacks, play fun sidewalk games, and eat and share the snacks you have created. Activities and snacking will all be tied together with terrific stories!

Summertime Painting with Ms. McNulty **Cost \$80 Session II (Grades 3-5)**

In this class we will explore summertime themes with tempera and watercolor paint. Paint a giant ladybug, a sailboat gliding along the ocean, your favorite summer flip flops and an ice cream cone. We will paint on canvas and paper.

Walk the Plank! A Pirate's Life for Me with Ms. Sargent **Cost \$85 (Grades K-2) Sessions III & IV**

Argh matey! It's a pirate's life for me! If you have always wanted to find buried treasure, then this is the class for you! We will be reading pirate stories, creating pirate crafts like treasure maps, playing "Swab the deck," and making "pirate booty" snacks (no utensils allowed!). Shiver me timbers!
