


9. Is before and after school day care available?

Full Day Kindergarten Opportunities

Socialization ~ Children will have increased opportunities to socialize in creative and cooperative play; further develop independent decision making; function effectively in groups.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What is required for Kindergarten registration?

- *2 proofs of residency
- *Original birth certificate
- *Physical and immunization records
- *Custody papers or other legal documents

2. When is the Kindergarten Orientation Day?

Each school will host their own Orientation. More detailed information will be sent to you at a later date.

3. What are the hours for the Kindergarten program?

The **full day program** runs Monday-Friday from 8:25 am to 2:55 pm.

The **half-day program** runs Monday-Friday. The morning session is from 8:25am ~ 11:10am and the afternoon session is from 12:10pm ~ 2:55pm.

4. What is the tuition rate for Kindergarten?

There is no charge for the **half-day program**. During the 2014/2015 school year, the tuition for the **full day program** is \$3,600.00. A monthly payment plan option is available.

5. Is there a difference in curriculum between half-day and full day?

Full day kindergarten students will be provided time for lunch, recess, and unified arts (art, music, physical education, library, computers). In addition, the full day program will include increased instructional time for Readers' Workshop, thematic units, intervention, and enrichment activities.

6. What is the maximum class size in a Kindergarten classroom?

The maximum class size in both the full day and the half-day programs is 18 students.

7. Does my child need a snack, lunch, or both?

If your child is scheduled for half-day program, he/she will need a snack and a drink. Milk or juice may be purchased from the school cafeteria.

If your child is scheduled for the full day program, you can pack him/her a lunch or purchase one at school. Your child will also need a snack and drink. Milk or juice may be purchased from the school cafeteria.

8. What are the transportation options?

Full day students may take the bus to and from school. Morning students may take the bus to school. Afternoon students may take the bus home. There is no midday transportation available for half-day students.
